





















# Latest Information Regarding Windows® 10 Creators Update




Updating Windows 10 will change operating procedures, display of screens, etc.

The main functions for which the operating procedures have changed from those described in the operating instructions and the functions for which caution is required during operation are as follows.

- Main functions for which the operating procedures are changed by the update

No.	Applicable function	Operating procedure after update
1	Control Panel	1. Click  (Start) - [Windows System] - [Control Panel].
2	Windows help	1. Connect to the Internet and click  (Start) -  (Tips).
3	Setting the size of text on screen	1. Click  (Start) -  (Settings). 2. Click [System] - [Display] and select the size in [Change the size of text, apps, and other items].
4	Setting the background of Desktop	1. Click  (Start) -  (Settings) - [Personalization]. 2. Click [Background].
5	Setting the sound	1. Click  (Start) -  (Settings) - [Personalization]. 2. Click [Themes] - [Sounds].
6	Setting the printer	1. Click  (Start) -  (Settings) - [Devices]. 2. Click [Printers & scanners].
7	Setting the mouse	1. Click  (Start) -  (Settings) - [Devices]. 2. Click [Mouse] - [Additional mouse options] - [Device Settings].
8	Setting the sleep	1. Right-click  (Start) and click [Power Options]. 2. Set the time in [On battery power, PC goes to sleep after] and [When plugged in, PC goes to sleep after] of [Sleep].
9	Advanced system settings	1. Right-click  (Start) and click [System]. 2. Click [System info] - [Advanced system settings]
10	Apps & features	1. Click  (Start) -  (Settings) - [Apps].
11	Registering a Bluetooth device	1. Click  (Start) -  (Settings) - [Devices]. 2. Click [Bluetooth & other devices].
12	Manual Selector (There are some models for which this has not changed.)	1. Click  (Start) - [Panasonic PC Manual Selector].

● Functions for which caution is required during operation

No.	Applicable function	Caution
1	Enabled/disabled indication of IEEE802.11a in Panasonic PC Settings Utility	Immediately after you sign into Windows (for approximately 3 minutes), [IEEE802.11a] may be indicated as [Disabled] in [Settings] -  (Network) screen of Panasonic PC Settings Utility even though IEEE802.11a is enabled. Check IEEE802.11a after 3 minutes or longer have elapsed since you signed in.
2	< FZ-M1 series > Operation at initial startup	Set the display to landscape in the Windows setup when using for the first time after purchase or after reinstalling. If the Windows setup is performed with the display set to portrait, some of the screen may not be displayed because it is hidden.
3	< Model with Wireless Switch > Disabling/Enabling Wireless Communication	Even if the wireless switch is set to OFF, wireless communication may become enabled when [Airplane mode] is set to OFF in the following procedure. 1. Slide the wireless switch to OFF. [Airplane mode] is set to ON, and wireless communication becomes disabled. 2. Click  (Start) -  (Settings) - [Network & Internet] – [Airplane mode], then set [Airplane mode] to OFF. Wireless switch is set to OFF, but wireless communication may become enabled. If wireless communication becomes enabled in the above procedure, slide the wireless switch to ON, then slide the wireless switch to OFF.

· Screen messages are explained in [English (United States)].

Depending on the language preference, some screen messages in these instructions are different from the actual screen messages. For example, [Flight mode] may be displayed instead of [Airplane mode] in some language preference.
